Cleveland Police apply for a review of the premises Licence at The Penny Black Public House on Langthorne Grove, Hartburn, Stockton, on grounds that it is undermining the Licensing objectives of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety.

The Penny Black is situated in it's own grounds in a highly populated residential area. It is a well established community public house and has, historically, been well attended by locals from the area.

At 5pm on 20th March 2020 the Prime Minister ordered the closure of all hospitality type premises including public houses from midnight that night. This has continued to this day and businesses are still waiting on an announcement as to when the order will be lifted. Premises are allowed to sell takeaway food and deliveries of food and alcohol as long as they have permission on their licence to sell alcohol for consumption off the premises which the Penny Black does.

As part of our ongoing duties we have been reacting to information from the public regarding premises which they believe are not abiding by the Health Protection Coronavirus Act 2020 regulations.

We have received numerous complaints from various members of the public regarding The Penny Black having people on site in the bar drinking.

Police attended on five separate occasions to engage, explain and encourage the licensee to work within the legislation laid down by the Government to combat the spread of Coronavirus, giving advice on best practice and what the regulations meant for him and his business.

- 26th March 2020 15:00 hours, Licensing Support officers to speak to the DPS Gary Cooke about posts on Facebook, saying they are allowing people to purchase food and then eat it in the beer garden. Cooke agreed to remove the post on advice that this is not permissible due to the Coronavirus restrictions at this time.
- 28th March 2020 21:00 hours Officers attended the premise after receiving complaints from the public that the premise was "open". At this time it was found that nothing was wrong, but the DPS was unable to show any CCTV footage as corroboration as due to ongoing alterations to the premises the CCTV was inoperative
- 31st March 2020 11:45 hours, licensing officers attended the premise to speak to Gary Cooke and explain what he can and can't do during the ongoing restrictions put in place by the government to try and slow the spread of Covid19.
- On 6th May 2020 at 18:35 hours after receiving more information from the public about people

drinking in the premise Licensing Officers attended to find a male sitting at the bar with a drink in front of him, who identified himself as a decorator who had been working in the premise. It was explained to the DPS and the male that they could not do this as it was in contravention of the Covid19 Restrictions. Again advice was given around the regulations to the DPS. Cooke was again asked for CCTV footage but stated that the CCTV was still not operational.

- 15th May 2020 16:50 hours Licensing officers attended the premise after receiving information that there were people in the premise drinking. On attending officers found 15+ people inside the premise many with alcoholic drinks in front of them, sitting at tables as though the premise was trading as normal. The DPS Gary Cooke was also sitting at the bar while this was going on and two female members of staff were behind the bar serving. The premise was cleared, one male was issued a fixed penalty notice as this was not the first time he was inside the premise with drink and the DPS was advised that Environmental Health would be notified and that they could issue a prohibition notice.
- Finally on 19th May 2020 at 15:55 hours PC894 Thorpe attended The Penny Black with senior Trading Standards Officer to issue the DPS Gary Cooke with a prohibition notice and was advised that further transgression would result in him being summonsed to court.

Despite trying to work with the licensee, on the last occasion officers found 15 or more people on site using the premises as though the lockdown was no longer in force, drinking alcohol sitting around tables together and at the bar, with the premises trading as before the Coronavirus legislations. This put not only his and his staffs health at risk, but also the patrons at the premise, the people they would be going home to and anyone they may come in to contact with during their everyday life.

The Operating Schedule contains few conditions on the Licence and has no legal requirement for CCTV, however Police consider the provision of CCTV to be a basic requirement at a busy licensed premises. The Pub is fitted with CCTV however the Premises Licence holder claims that he does not know how it works.

On the 10th February 2020, the Premises Licence Holder reported a robbery at 03:11 where £13,000 in takings was stolen by 2 men who threatened staff with a spade and a crow bar. This crime was investigated by CID who contacted Cleveland Police Licensing Unit stating that the Premises Licence holder was not providing the CCTV. PC Arbuckle from the Licensing Unit contacted the Premises Licence Holder who claimed that he didn't know how to work the CCTV but was getting someone to do it. The Officers dealing had to arrange for the Technical Support Unit to attend to download the footage. The suspects could not be identified from the footage.

On a Police Visit on the 28th March 2020 regarding breaches of Covid Legislation, PC Westmoreland asked the Premises Licence Holder about the CCTV and he informed he he could not work it and she would have to look at it herself.

On the 5th August 2020, PC Arbuckle spoke to the Premises Licence Holder regarding CCTV for Saturday 1st August. This was following information from Stockton Council that the premises had again been breaching Covid legislation with people dancing inside the premises. PC Arbuckle was told that the CCTV was not working at all.

Cleveland Police are aware that Stockton Council has received a number of noise complaints about the premises since it reopened.

Not only have Cleveland Police spoken to the operator about each of these incidents, Cleveland Police have also spoken to the owners Star Pubs about these concerns.

Cleveland Police are of the view that the premises Licence holder is undermining the Licensing objectives of Crime and Disorder, Public Nuisance and Public Safety

I am a serving police officer with Cleveland Police. I am currently stationed with the Licensing Support Unit at Middlesbrough Police HQ.

Part of my role as a licensing support officer is to monitor licensed premises within Hartlepool and Stockton districts ensuring that they are trading within the spirit of the four licensing objectives. We will ask that they will not have an adverse affect on the surrounding community or have a negative impact on Crime & Disorder, Public Safety or Public Nuisance objectives and will Prevent Harm to Children.

This statement is in relation to a request to review the licence of an on-licensed premise, The Penny Black Public House, Langthorne Grove, Hartburn, Stockton. Cleveland Police request this review as we believe The Penny Black has failed to uphold two of the licensing objectives, namely Preventing Crime and Disorder and Public Safety.

The Penny Black is situated in a heavily populated residential area which has a mixture of

families and elderly people. It is set in its own grounds with it's own beer garden and car park. Whilst it backs on to fields, it is surrounded on the other three sides by private residences.

The Penny Black's Premise Licence is held by Gary Alan COOKE who is also named as the Designated Premise Supervisor (DPS). The premise licence in its current form has been in place since 1st November 2017.

On 20th March 2020 at 17:00 hours the Prime Minister issued a public statement, that certain businesses should cease trading on site, and that alcohol and food could no longer be served to be consumed on the premise or land adjacent to the premise from midnight that day or as soon as practicable. As a result of that announcement legislation was put in to place to support this under the Coronavirus Act 2020.

The legislation put out by Public Health England under the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Business Closure)(England) Regulations 2020 state:

Requirement to close premises and businesses during the emergency

2.

(1) A person who is responsible for carrying on a business which is listed in Part 1 of the Schedule must—

(a) 1984 c. 22. Part 2A was inserted by section 129 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 (c.14).

2 (a) during the relevant period—

(i) close any premises, or part of the premises, in which food or drink are sold for consumption on those premises, and

(ii) cease selling food or drink for consumption on its premises; or

(b) if the business sells food or drink for consumption off the premises, cease selling food or drink for consumption on its premises during the relevant period.

It also goes on to specify -

(3) For the purposes of paragraph (1)(a)(ii) and (b), an area adjacent to the premises of the business where seating is made available for customers of the business (whether or not by the business) to be treated as part of the premises of that business.

Part 1 of the regulations includes Bars and Public Houses as businesses to close.

We have since 25th March 2020 received several pieces of intelligence from members of the public and councillors with concerns that the premise was trading as normal or that they were carrying out business in contravention of the regulations. These were motivated by peoples desire to see the steps to slow the pandemic work and the lockdown to be as effective as possible.

On 26th March 2020 Cleveland police received information that the Penny Black was advertising on Facebook that they were setting up their beer garden so that people collecting "takeaway food" from them could sit in the beer garden and eat their food. Unfortunately due to the regulations laid out in the Health Protection Coronavirus Act 2020 this is not allowed as this would be classed as land adjacent to the premises where seating is made available to

customers. At 15:00 hours the same day Licensing Officers attended the premise and spoke to the Designated Premise Supervisor (DPS) Gary Cooke and explained fully why he was not able to use the beer garden to allow people to eat the food and showed him the part of the Act which is relevant to licensed premises such as his. We gave him advice about the best way to supply takeaway food as he expressed a wish to do this and even suggested he might want to take the food out to customers rather than have them come on to the premise to protect the customers and his staff.

On 28th March 2020 further information was received that members of the public were seeing people in the bar area, playing pool, watching television and drinking alcohol from the bar. Officers attended the premise at 21:00 hours the same day including a Licensing Officer. When they attended there were three males and one female present in the bar area consuming alcohol. The officers spoke to the licensee Gary Cooke who stated that all the people present resided at The Penny Black, The other two males rented rooms at the premise. He was asked if he was able to show officers the CCTV but stated that due to ongoing alterations to the premise the CCTV was not operating. There was money in the till but the licensee stated this was from the sale of takeaway meals.

On Tuesday 31st March 2020 at 11:45 hours myself and Sergeant Paul Higgins from the Licensing Support Unit attended The Penny Black Public House to speak to the licensee Gary Cooke, to identify the persons at the premise and fully explain what they can and can't do in accordance with the regulations laid down by the government. It was established that three males (the licensee, the chef and another male) and one female (the licensee's partner)

resided at the premise. One of the males refused to give his name verbally as he believed this formed a verbal contract with the police and would only write his name down for us. We advised that they could not supply alcohol or food for consumption in the premise or allow use of any of the facilities (toilets etc.). We gave advice on not sitting at the bar drinking in sight of public walking by, we, again, also advised rather than supplying the food for takeaway in the bar area, to ask people to wait outside and take the food out. It was also established that the DPS could not work the CCTV system and could not provide CCTV readily if requested. The licensee appeared to take all of this on board and promised that no other persons were drinking or eating in the premise.

We received another e-mail from a member of the public informing us that they were aware of people they knew drinking in the Penny Black. As result of the e-mail on Wednesday 6th May 2020 at 18:35 hours Licensing Officers attended the Penny Black. We found the chef present, the other male resident, a male waiting for takeaway food and another male at the bar drinking, what we ascertained from the male to be lager, from a Fosters glass. When challenged the male stated he was a decorator carrying out work on the premise and that he had been given a free pint while he waited for his food. We advised that no alcohol was to be served to be consumed on the premise free or otherwise and went to great pains to explain why to all present and were told it would not happen again.

On Friday 15th May 2020 at 16:50 hours we received a telephone call from a member of the public stating that there were a number of people in The Penny Black at that moment drinking in the premise as though lockdown restrictions had been lifted. At 17:10 hours the same day I

attended the premise with my colleague PC Emma Westmoreland. On entering we found 15 or more people in the premise, many had pints of lager or other alcohol in front of them or drinking from them, there were a few shots on tables as well, and two males were sat at the bar with alcoholic drinks in front of them. The DPS Gary Cooke was sat at the bar with a pint glass in front which appeared to contain an alcoholic beverage of him as well. One of the males at the bar was the decorator who had been challenged on previous occasions. There were also two female bar staff serving behind the bar, one was the female partner of the DPS. The bar was cleared and the decorator was given a Fixed Penalty Fine for his persistent breaching of the regulations. We spoke at length, again to the DPS Gary Cooke who had no defence to his failure to abide with the regulations. Cooke stated that he could not provide CCTV footage as the CCTV system was in not working while the decorating and refurbishment of the premises was being carried out. Cooke was advised that we would notify Trading Standards who would likely issue a prohibition notice, and advised that until that point the doors should be kept locked and any takeaway orders that they needed to fulfill must be taken to the customers outside and nobody but staff and people residing at the residence should be allowed in. Mr. Cooke agreed to this and stated he understood what he had been told.

On Tuesday 19th May 2020 at 15:55 hours I once again attended The Penny Black Public House with the Senior Trading Standards officer, where Gary Cooke was issued with and accepted a Prohibition Notice and was advised that any further transgressions would result in him being summonsed to court. Mr. Cooke was also advised by me that we would be looking to review the premise licence due to his persistent flouting of the laws around the Health

Protection (Coronavirus) Act 2020 and his disregard for Public Safety. Mr. Cooke stated he understood and was apologetic for his part in what had occurred and promised it would not happen again.

Since this time regulations have been relaxed and the premise has been allowed to reopen again on 4th July 2020. Unfortunately complaints have continued from members of the public and the council regarding noise from the premise, people and vehicles in the car park attached to the premise, concerns over social distancing, the number of people in the premise and safe operating of the premise. I have provided some examples of these complaints to the police.

We will always look to the review process as being the last recourse for any licensed premises. Unfortunately, we have tried to work with Mr. Cooke visiting on numerous occasions and taking the time to discuss the regulations and offer advice and best practice while the restrictions and lockdown is in place. We have gone to great lengths to engage, explain and encourage Mr. Cooke to do things properly without the need to enforce the regulations. Even with these interventions matters have escalated until we have found the premise trading as though all restrictions have been lifted, putting, not only the staff, the licensee and the patrons at risk but the wider family units of these people and other innocent members of the public who may come in to contact with them during their daily routines.

As such not only has Mr. Cooke disregarded the legislation laid down by the government he has also flagrantly disregarded Public Safety, leaving us with little choice but to seek a review of the premise licence.

I am a Police Constable in Cleveland Police presently stationed at Middlesbrough Police Station in the Licensing Support Unit.

On Saturday 28th March 2020 at 20:30 hours I was on mobile patrol when I was requested to attend The PENNY BLACK, ELLERTON ROAD, HARTBURN by officers conducting patrols to identify and deal with any Covid - 19 breaches. I made my way directly to the premise and entered the bar area. Awaiting my attendance in the bar was Sgt 1832 BARCLAY and another officer. Upon entering the bar I could see that all the lights were switched on and the large TV on the wall was on. Present in the room was Gary COOKE, the licensee, a female, and two males. One of who I recognised from a visit I had made to the pub on the 26th March 2020 at that time the male had been painting the ceiling in the bar area and was working as a decorator.

I tried to speak to COOKE regarding him having people in the premise who do not live there but he was intoxicated and accused the police of bullying him as this was the third visit he'd had regarding Covid regulations. I asked COOKE why he had people in the pub and I was informed by him that the male with dreadlocks and the unknown male resided

with him in the accommodation above the premise and that his girlfriend was working as they were selling takeaways. He was unable to account for the decorator's presence on the premise. I spoke to the decorator and asked him to leave the venue stating he was breaching the Covid regulations by been present in the pub. He agreed to leave and phoned a taxi. I attempted to speak to COOKE further regarding having persons on the premise however he refused to engage with me. When asking COOKE if he had CCTV on the premise he stated that he did but that he did not know how to work it and told me to do it myself.

On the 6th May 2020 at 18:35 hours me and PC 894 THORPE attended THE PENNY BLACK again, upon entering the premise I switched on my body worn video camera, I exhibit this footage as EEW/1. Upon entering the bar area I saw a female stood behind the bar, A male with dreadlocks seated at the high table in the centre of the room with an unknown male. Also present was the decorator who I'd spoken to on two previous occasions. He was sat at the bar drinking a pint of lager, when I asked him why he was there he stated he had just finished decorating and was having a drink before leaving. PC 894 Thorpe spoke to the decorator explaining why he could not be in the pub after he finished working, as at that time he was socialising and that regulations had been brought in to enforce social distancing. Danny was asked to leave the pub whilst the others present were allowed to stay as they were residing at the property.

On the 15th May 2020 at about 16:50 hours myself and PC 894 THORPE attended THE PENNY BLACK after receiving complaints from concerned members of the public reporting that the premise was open. Upon our arrival at the venue I could see that the blinds were

drawn in the bar preventing me seeing inside on all my other visits the blinds had been open. I entered the bar through the unlocked main entrance. Upon entering the bar area I was shocked at the amount of people sat and stood around consuming alcohol and soft drinks.

Directly in front of me was a low table with three or four people sat around it each with a drink, to the right of that was another table again with people situated around it. In the centre of the room was a high table with seats for six persons. People were standing and sitting around the table. There were partially drunk glasses of alcoholic and soft drinks on the table and a tray of empty shot glasses. COOKE the licensee was sat at the bar on a stool with a full pint. Behind the bar were two females. There were approximately 15-17 persons in the premise breaching the covid-19 closure order. Everyone that was present was asked to leave which they did. PC 894 THORPE issued a fixed penalty notice to the decorator, who was one again consuming alcohol.

I spoke to COOKE who confirmed that the CCTV was not working in the premise due to him getting a new system installed and that he was embarrassed to have been caught in the situation.
