The Environmental Health Unit are in support of this Review as there are some significant concerns regarding the current management of this premises.

Historically, this premises has had a few issues judged as minor misdemeanours such as

2011-998278 - noise event with door open

2011/12-A39830 - Noise event with doors open

2014-C89540 - disposal of glassware at inappropriate times

2014-D30111 Noise event with doors open

2014-D38295 noise event loud music after hours

2015-D93360 loud music after hours

2018-F82357 loud music after hours

Environmental Health have informed the Designated Premises Supervisor of the issues and these have been rectified without any formal action.

However, in 2020 this has changed, with the premises being open during lockdown and requiring formal Closure. A Prohibition Notice was served under Regulation 8(2) of The Health protection (Coronavirus Restrictions) (England) Regulations 2020 on the 19th May 2020 and accepted by Mr Gary Cooke.

The Environmental Health Unit are currently investigating several ongoing complaints about Noise from the premises, both inside and out, written notification has been sent to both the Licence Holder and the registered Designated Premises Supervisor.

The Council's Civic Enforcement Team have received additional calls which have required verbal advise and warnings from our On-call Environmental Health Officer to be given to staff present during the music events to ensure the appropriate controls are put in place.

In addition, the police have received calls regarding noise from Premises on the 11/09/20 at 22:50 hours stating that there was loud music and shouting coming from the premise.

However, no communication has been received from either the License Holder or the Designated Premises Supervisor demonstrating a lack of Management resolve to improve this situation.
