Cleveland Police make an application to review this premises licence for the following reasons:

Since 5th November 2020, public houses have been required to close, (unless they are serving takeaway food and then customers must leave the premises to consume), as restricted businesses due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. This is required through law, firstly by The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (England) (No4) Regulations 2020 and then by The Health Protections (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (All Tiers) (England) Regulations 2020". On the whole, premises have remained closed to prevent the spread of the virus and keep the public safe.

The Porky Pint, 40 Mill Lane, Billingham has been open and trading on three occasions over the past three months. These occasions were 12th and 20th November 2020 and 30th January 2021. Cleveland Police and Stockton Borough Council have attended the premise on the three occasions in question when the restrictions were in place and found the premise to be trading and people to be in the premises drinking alcohol. On each occasion it was found that staff were on site serving from the bar, and there were customers in the bar either drinking or eating at the tables. Police also received two further reports from members of the public also stating that this has been happening.

Both Cleveland Police and Stockton Borough Council have attempted to engage with Mr Henderson, the premises licence holder and Designated Premises Supervisor, to try to explain the reasons that the premise needs to remain closed and the potential consequences of his repeated refusal to keep the business closed. Mr Henderson has steadfastly refused to cooperate, has breached the COVID -19 Regulations and has, on at least one occasion, stated he does not recognise the Coronavirus Act 2020 and associated Regulations as legitimate legislation.

During the incidents on 12th November 2020 and 20th November 2020, there was

government legislation in force under The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (England) (No.4) Regulations 2020 which clearly states:-

15.—(1) A person responsible for carrying on a restricted business, or providing a restricted service, must—

(a) close any premises, or part of the premises, in which food or drink are provided for consumption on those premises, and

(b) cease providing food or drink for consumption on its premises.

There are a number of exceptions to this rule which do not apply in this case and these Regulations cover the 12th and 20th November breaches.

For the incident which occurred on 30th January 2021, The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (All Tiers) (England) Regulations 2020” were in force as amended on 6th January 2021, however the principle of closure of pubs/ bars has remained the same from 5th November.

From 6 January 2021, a new national lockdown applied in all of England. You can only leave home for work purposes where it is unreasonable for you to do your job from home. Hospitality venues are required to close, including cafes, restaurants, pubs, bars and social clubs. This is with the exception of providing food and non-alcoholic drinks for takeaway (until 11pm), click-and-collect and drive-through. All food and drink (including alcohol) can continue to be provided by delivery.

On 12th February 2021, Council Licensing Officer and two Licensing officers attended the premises requesting CCTV footage of Saturday 30th January 2021 between 12:00-18:00 hours and Saturday 6th February 2021 between 12:00 – 18:00 hours. Mr. Henderson said he would not provide footage without an official written request to be put in writing and that he did not think he had a condition in his licence which compelled him to provide footage. Stockton Borough Council sent an e-mail to Mr. Henderson, on 12th February 2021 formally requesting the footage and stating that as he was trading on these dates it was part of his licensing conditions to supply the footage to the police or any responsible authority requesting the footage within 24 hours.

The Licence conditions state as follows with regard to CCTV footage:-

“There will be at all times a member of staff on duty who is trained in the use of the equipment and upon receipt of a request for footage from a governing body, such as Cleveland Police or any other Responsible Authority, be able to produce the footage within a reasonable time, e.g. 24hrs routine or less if urgently required for investigation of serious crime”

Whilst appreciating Mr Henderson’s right to seek independent legal advice, the condition on his licence states that a trained person should be at the premises in a position to provide any CCTV to Cleveland Police in a timely matter e.g. within 24 hours. Although the request was made verbally on 12th February, the CCTV has still not been provided and there was no trained person in a position to do this at the premises on 12th February, hence this condition has also been breached.

Mr Henderson has shown a complete disregard for the legislation which the Government implemented to safeguard the public from a devastating pandemic which has been responsible for the deaths of many thousands and left even more with serious ongoing health issues. The premises should not have been open at all on the three occasions detailed and Mr Henderson does not want to listen to advice or acknowledge the legality of the coronavirus legislation. We would unfortunately ask that the committee consider a revocation of the premise licence in light of Mr Henderson’s refusal to abide by the governments legislation and to adhere to his own premises licence and conditions which he himself agreed to.

Under the circumstances, Cleveland Police are left with no alternative other than to bring this application for review

I am the above named officer currently based at Stockton IRT C relief North.

On FRIDAY 13TH NOVEMBER 2020 I was on duty on mobile patrol in a marked police vehicle call sign SCovid. Control room assigned me an incident whereby it had been reported that the micropub PORKY PINTS in BILLINGHAM was still open and not abiding by covid guidelines.

Upon arriving at the establishment at approximately 16:30hrs I have noticed immediately there were lights on at the premises and people entering and exiting the building.

As I have entered the building I have noticed to the right of me a TV screen playing sports whereby there were approximately 6 males drinking pints sat within close proximity of each other. I have walked through to the left hand side where there were two female staff members serving hot sandwiches. There were a further 6-8 persons sat around tables also drinking alcoholic beverages. The staff members immediately approached me and told me to phone the manager.

I explained that there were issues around the Covid Guidelines and them being open and the female stated that she had been told by her manager to remain open and that if police attended to provide his number. The female staff members did not provide any details. The managers mobile number was provided to me and I was given the name PAUL.

Continuation statement of:

I have contacted the manager who has stated the information is correct and that his establishment is open and that he refuses to close. PAUL went on to state that he abides by his license and that he has researched into the covid guidelines and has been informed he is not required to shut. I have spoken to PAUL about enforcing covid restrictions such as track and trace and social distancing and he stated that he believes this is a breach of human rights and confirmed he is not doing this.

I have spoken with control room who have liaised with response supervision and I have been advised to remain outside the premises until licensing and further units arrive due to the number of people inside the building.

PC Taylor has assisted me and arrived at the establishment and within 5 minutes we seen staff leaving the building and closing the pub. Staff refused to leave details and stated that PAUL had ordered them to close the building, they were unaware at that time if they would be required to work the following day.

I recontacted PAUL who confirmed he had asked staff to close up due to police presence, he added that he would be opening the following day, PC Taylor informed licensing off this.

I played no further part in this incident.

I am a serving police officer with Cleveland Police. I am currently stationed with the Licensing Support Unit at Middlesbrough Police HQ.

Part of my role as a licensing support officer is to monitor licensed premises within Hartlepool and Stockton districts ensuring that they are trading within the spirit of the four licensing objectives. We will ask that they will not have an adverse affect on the surrounding community or have a negative impact on Crime & Disorder, Public Safety or Public Nuisance objectives and will Prevent Harm to Children.

This statement is in relation to a request to review the licence of an on-licensed premise, The Porky Pint, Mill Lane, Billingham. Cleveland Police request this review as we believe The Porky Pint has failed to uphold two of the licensing objectives, namely Preventing Crime and Disorder and Public Safety.

The Porky Pint is situated in a row of retail premises with their own parking bays in front

I am Special Constable 4753 WILLIAMS, currently volunteering my service for CLEVELAND POLICE and stationed at STOCKTON POLICE STATION.

At 1610 hours on 30th January 2021. I was on duty in full uniform when I attended the PORKY PINT, MILL LANE, BILLINGHAM. I attended this location due to staff from STOCKTON COUNCIL'S licencing unit contacting police to report a COVID breach at the PORKY PINT and had seen people drinking alcohol in the premises. Upon my attendance I entered the pub via the front door as it was open. Once inside I was directed to a room at the front of the building which had around 6 people seated around a table, which had drinking glasses placed upon it. This suggested to me that these people had been using the premises' facilities. I did not speak to any persons directly whilst in the premises though did observe a male who I now know to be Paul HENDERSON being spoken to by my colleague PC 2861 LEONARD. I overheard HENDERSON stating to my colleague that he had opened his premises to support people who were suffering with mental health and other issues that may have arisen through the current COVID crisis.

Once my colleague had finished speaking with the premises owner, we left the building via the front door leaving only the owner and staff within the premises.

I am Detective Constable 2255 YAU, currently employed by CLEVELAND POLICE and stationed at MIDDLESBROUGH POLICE STATION.

At 1610 hours on 30th January 2021 I was on duty in full uniform when I attended the PORKY PINT, MILL LANE, BILLINGHAM. I attended this location due to staff from STOCKTON COUNCIL'S licencing unit contacting police to report a COVID breach at the PORKY PINT and had seen people drinking alcohol in the premises. Upon my attendance I entered the pub which was open and spoke with a male I now know to be Paul HENDERSON who informed me he was the owner/licensee of the pub. HENDERSON told me he had people in the pub as he held a vulnerable support group and regular business meetings for anyone who wanted to become a stakeholder in his buisness. HENDERSON also said both are permitted under government guidelines which he said he had confirmed after seeking advice with a solicitor.

I asked HENDERSON if he could provide any proof regarding hosting a vulnerable support group such as how was it advertised, any social media posts, emails, text messages, documentation and HENDERSON said he didn't have any and it was all via word of mouth. With regards to holding buisness meetings I also asked to see any documentation or proof as to how these were organised, names of any persons who had previously

attended and details regarding becoming a stakeholder. Again HENDERSON did not have any proof or evidence this was the case. I asked HENDERSON if he would ask the people in his pub who were not there to collect takeaway to leave, HENDERSON replied that I could ask them. HENDERSON and I then walked into the main room where the bar was located to find 6 people sat at tables, not socially distancing and not wearing masks. Two of the males in this group of 6 were drinking alcohol. As HENDERSON and I walked into this room HENDERSON spoke to the group and informed them that I wanted them to leave but he wanted them to stay. I then explained to the group any person wishing to seek support for vulnerability can do so via charities or organisations set up by government or local councils and they could not meet in a pub over a pint to discuss their issues. I then explained that any person wanting to discuss business with HENDERSON could do so over the phone, zoom call or any other electronic method but did not need to do so in person over a pint. I then asked all persons present to leave. Initially they refused and I replied if they did not leave they would be issued a £200.00 fine. 5 members of the group then left and one male who I now know to be [REDACTED] refused to leave and said to me "I WANT TO GET THE FINE SO I CAN CONTEST IT AT COURT". I asked [REDACTED] why he had attended this pub and he replied for a business meeting, he had attended to speak to HENDERSON for business advice regarding a business he runs. 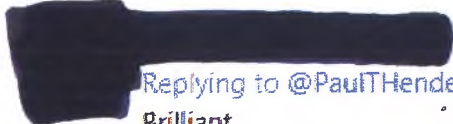
