I have no objection to recorded, low level background music being played within the premises.</b></p>

<p>I object to live music being played at the premises between the hours of 9am and 11pm:</p> <p>I have two young children and our house is over the road from this property. It will be detrimental to their health and development if they are unable to sleep on an evening as a result of the noise which will emanate from the building, if live music is permitted.</p> <p>I work flexible hours from home, both during the day and on an evening. Live music will be heard within our property, which will prevent me from being able to concentrate, and affect the quality of my work.</p> <p>Live music will also affect my family's right to peacefully enjoy our home.</p> <p>When permission was granted to convert the premises into a restaurant, the following condition was imposed:</p> <p><i>There shall be no amplified music. Music shall be background level only and not cause a disturbance at any residence within the vicinity.</i></p> <p><i>Reason: To protect the amenities of nearby residents</i></p> <p>Clearly the planning department feel that live and amplified music would cause distress to local residents, and I would agree.</p> <p>I also note that section L of the application states that they intend to open until 11.30pm at night. However, planning conditions state they are permitted to open between 9.00am and 11pm.</p>
