Good morning,

I wish to strongly object to the licence being granted to the Ingleby Cafe at 1 Beckfields Centre to serve alcohol and to play music.

On the grounds that there's already anti social behaviour and a litter problem directly outside the Ingleby Cafe. With people congregating on that part of Beckfields Centre.

We already have the Beckfields Pub serving alcohol. Which more than satisfies the needs of the community.

I also object to the granting of a music licence. The noise coming from the Beckfields Pub especially on a weekend is intolerable in the evening. We don't need another venue with music blasting out of it.

I can hear the Beckfields Pub music from my property. The Ingleby Cafe is closer to my property than the Beckfields Pub. I'm sure I'll be able to hear it.

I note that the authority normally grants licences with conditions that state the door of the venue close automatically behind anyone leaving or entering as to stop noise escaping the premises. However, this really doesn't stop the noise escaping.
