The grounds of the representation is based on the following:

(Try to be as specific as possible and give examples of any evidence you may have e.g. on 1 June I could hear loud music from the premises between 10pm and 1.am. I am concerned that if the premises open until after 2am this will cause a nuisance to me and other residents of the street)

Contacted by Resident initially on 1st and 2nd August. Large groups of drinkers gathering inside the Penny Black and outside sitting in cars (music blasting). Nuisance went on until 1.15am. I spoke to Paul in enforcement and the police had been contacted directly by residents. I was assured the licensee had been spoken to.

However noise problems and late openings continued for 5 consecutive weekends.

14th August asked Enforcement to attend, rang me 20.57 when they visited the car park but did not enter premises. Informed by licensing on 18th August that a review of premises was to be scheduled.

On Bank holiday weekend, live music was played until 11.30pm, although the pub remained open till late. The current conditions on the license do not allow live music till this time. The volume was also considered to be excessive and a nuisance to residents, many of whom are elderly.

Other evidence of anti social behaviour on the car park include discarded nitrous oxide canisters

Unacceptable nuisance during the pandemic.
