The 2 premises mentioned , belonging to the same person I believe, are to serve alcohol throughout the day into the late evening, 11 o'clock and until 12.30 am , Friday, Saturday and Sunday. This is a very small residential area

with houses at the back of both premises being literally a few yards from private houses, some with children. . This area at the moment is already an absolute nightmare due to traffic gridlocks by parents with children in the nearby school parking cheek to jowl along the streets preventing residents access to their own properties. People coming to these proposed premises will no doubt add to this problem. This is dangerous for the children coming out of school (during the cafe opening times, especially where alcohol is involved) as there is often very little space to cross.

Provide the grounds for the representation

The late night opening is totally unacceptable to residents due to the additional noise, which will carry on to the early hours. The pub a few yards away is already testimony to that. Violence is another problem where alcohol is involved. We already have to suffer this from some residents of the Teal arms pub a few metres away.

Private vehicles parked outside are targets for criminal damage. The area is rife with drug dealing, we have been in constant touch with the police about it which happens outside of our houses. Speaking to all the residents in this small area many are appalled by the thought of our problems being added to. Specific dates for problems are too numerous to identify, but the police can provide details should it be necessary, they are in constant attendance. My husband and son have been threatened when trying to prevent criminal damage to our property due to youths high on drink and drugs. More available alcohol can only add to this problem.

There is also the problem of rubbish being piled behind the backs of the shops and takeaways on the same block of the proposed cafe and bistro. The bins are constantly overflowing and the food scraps attract rats and seagulls. This is a nightmare.

I know this is very detailed but has been going on for years, more than long enough so it would be impossible to give specific incidents as previously stated. The police are well aware and are in attendance when possible. We don't need the problems added to..

I have tried unsuccessfully to fill in the council forms, I spoke to Dawn Hand who was very helpful and sent me a link, but this would not open. Dawn phoned her supervisor and I was told under the circumstances I could e mail my objections.

The Onion Bistro 24 Greenside Ingleby Barwick

I wish to raise some concerns over this application, I have been contacted by a number of residents who live close by;

The first complaint is that this was originally proposed as a laundrette, it did seem extremely strange that someone would wish to build a laundrette on the estate. Was this just a ploy to get planning permission? Would the applicant have gained planning permission had they applied for a Bistro?

I supported Ingleby Bistro following a meeting with the owners after they agreed to reduce the licensing hours, and this has been a huge success. I understand that the Beckfields have had increased customers due to people visiting before and or after going to the Bistro. This could be the same with the Teal.

I believe that the opening hours should be the same as the Ingleby Bistro if a license is granted and the same restriction imposed on Ingleby Bistro should be imposed on these premises. Car parking could be an issue as I understand the owners of the car park are imposing a "Parking Eye" system and charging for parking in the near future, this will mean that customers for the Bistro will be charged a parking fee and to prevent them getting a fine the Bistro should have provision for advising customers of the parking fee should it come into effect.

Greedy Soul Café and Deli 16 Greenside Ingleby Barwick

I object to granting these premises a license as this will mean that 3 out of the 9 premises on the parade of shops are all selling alcohol. I have no problem with it being a café but I believe a third premise selling alcohol (assuming The Onion Bistro are successful in gaining a license) is one too many.

The premises are right next door to the Teal and would impact on their business.
