This report provides an overview on recorded crime, anti-social behaviour incidents and domestic abuse in the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees for the 12-month period. The bulk of the statistics utilised for this report have been obtained from Cleveland Police crime statistic databases with the figures correct at the time of data extraction. The data is extracted from a 'live' systems and therefore remains the subject of on-going operational activity, audit and scrutiny.



Publicly reported offences

- **VIOLENCE** overall is up 7.9% however, Stalking and Harassment indicates a 2.9% decrease.
- **Death or serious injury caused by illegal driving** shows the largest decrease down -66.7%.
- **SEXUAL OFFENCES** overall increased by 23.7%.




