



- Proposed POC Tree
Trees to be planted as 10-20cm girth, semi-mature, min 4m high, to be raised and secured with suitable rubber ties.
 - Proposed Medium Tree
Trees to be planted as 12-24cm girth, semi-mature, 3-4m high, to be raised and secured with suitable rubber ties.
 - Proposed Small Tree
Trees to be planted as 10-12cm girth or 25cm girth, 2-3m high and secured with single white and suitable rubber ties.
 - Proposed Formal Hedge
Conventional hedge to be planted at 1000mm, 1.5m, or 2m in 1m.
 - Proposed Native Hedge
10-150mm, 80cm, planted as a double staggered row at 3000mm centres.
 - Proposed Native Buffer Planting
Native shrubs to be 10-150mm girth in groups of 3 or 5 protected by tubes or spun guard. Shrub species should include a mix of native species which provide berries, bracts and flowers to attract a range of species such as bats, birds and invertebrates.
 - Proposed Ornamental Planting
Mixed shrubs and herbaceous plantings, 3-10cm girth with 10-15 specimens. Planting beds to receive 10cm depth ornamental bark mulch.
 - Proposed Wildflower Meadow
To be managed (10-15cm) General Purpose Meadow Mix.
 - Proposed Established POC Grass
To be laid or seeded.
 - Proposed Anemity Grass
Front and back gardens to client specification.

Installed on site bench. Eg: Urban Seat as supplied by Urban Urban.
 - Proposed Street Light
Eg: Vision Street as supplied by Urban Urban.
 - 200mm High edge to planter
Eg: Conventional kerb as supplied by Urban Urban.
 - Paving Type 1 - Pavement
Eg: Tarmac or similar.
 - Paving Type 2 - Road
Eg: Tarmac or similar.
 - Paving Type 3 - Footpath
Eg: Tarmac or similar.
