

## THE EDUCATION CENTRE FIRE EVACUATION PROCEDURE

## On Hearing a Fire Alarm

- Leave the building promptly by the nearest available Fire Exit following your identified Fire Evacuation Route.
- Remember to shut doors behind you where possible.
- If you find smoke is blocking your exit then go to your next nearest Fire Exit.
- Do NOT block any exits
- Once you have evacuated the building move away from the Centre and gather at the Fire Assembly Point
- Do NOT go back into the building under any circumstances until you are specifically told to do so by a member of the Fire Brigade. Please note the silencing of the alarms is NOT a signal to re-enter the building.
- If there are disabled people, injured people or others who cannot leave the building then inform the Fire Wardens of exactly where they are in the building. Do NOT try to assist them yourself.
