RECORDED CRIME & ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

Introduction

- 1. This report provides an overview on recorded crime, anti-social behaviour incidents and domestic abuse in the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees for the 12-month period of October 2023 to the end of October 2024.
- The bulk of the statistics utilised for this report have been obtained from Cleveland Police crime statistic databases with the figures correct at the time of data extraction (08/11/2024). The data is extracted from 'live' systems and therefore remains the subject of on-going operational activity, audit and scrutiny.
- 3. This report will not provide any detailed analysis unless there are any substantial changes to patterns or trends.
- 4. A comparison against other similar Community Safety Partnerships utilising iQuanta is noted within a separate report (This report is a RESTRICTED document due to the statistical information only made available as an intelligence tool until released by the Home Office).
- 5. Any references to rates per 1,000 population are based on the ONS UK Mid-year population estimates for 2021.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

<u>Crime</u>

The rate per 1,000 population (all ages)¹ for publicly reported crime in Stockton-on-Tees was 107.2 for October 2023 to the end of October 2024.

Between October 2023 - October 2024, there were 17,1765 publicly reported offences, which is a decrease of 2642 crimes (or - 12.9%) on the same period in the previous year. Police generated crime, which includes crimes such as drug offences, public disorder and possession of weapons has decreased by 597 crimes in comparison with the previous period, giving total police generated crime figure of 3353 offences, down 15.1% on the same period the previous year. Overall, there was a total of 21,118 crimes, equal to 3239 (13.3%) less crimes compared with the same period last year.

Comparing the number of crimes recorded in the period October 2023 - October 2024 versus October 2022 - October 2023, there were more of the following crime types recorded in the Borough:

Trafficking of Drugs

Comparing the number of crimes recorded in the period October 2023 - October 2024 versus October 2022 - October 2023, there were fewer of the following crime types recorded in the Borough:

Compared with October 2023 - October 2024 versus October 2022 - October 2023, the largest reduction (-50%) in Police recorded offences in Stockton-on-Tees was in relation to Homicide.

Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)

As at 31/10/24, reports of ASB to **Cleveland Police** show that across the Borough in the last 12 months, there was 4,695 ASB incidents, which is a decrease of -7.3% on the previous 12 months.

Between October 2023 - October 2024, 4,233 Service Requests were recorded by **Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council** Civic Enforcement team as ASB (including noise and alcohol issues). This is equal to a decrease of 833 incidents (-16.4%) in the last year. In the same comparative period, the number of begging incidents was 509, equal to -148; and the number of rowdy/nuisance behaviour incidents was 803, equal to -315.

<u>Crime:</u> October 2023 - October 2024 <u>versus</u> October 2022 - October 2023

Table 1 below shows the number of crimes that have been recorded in Stockton-on-Tees between October 2023 - October 2024 and Table 2 provides a one-month snapshot of the same for the last available month (October 2024). Please note, this does not necessarily mean that the crime occurred during that month, but it is the date that the crime was reported to Cleveland Police.

Key to note in Table 1 below, between October 2023 - October 2024:

- There were 17,765 publicly reported offences, which is a decrease of 2,642 crimes (or a decrease of 12.9%) on the same period in the previous year. The largest reduction was in relation to Homicide and the largest increase was in relation to Trafficking of Drugs.
- Police generated crime, which includes crimes such as drug offences, public disorder and possession of weapons has decreased by a further 597 crimes, giving a total police generated crime figure of 3,353 offences, down 15.1% on the same period the previous year.
- Overall, there was a total of 21,118 crimes in the current period, equal to 3,239 (13.3%) less crimes in the same period last year.
- The rate per 1,000 population (all ages)² for publicly reported crime in Stockton-on-Tees was 107.2 for October 2023 October 2024. This has increased from a rate of 123.6 in the same period last year.

Key to note in Table 2 below:

- In October 2024, 1,476 publicly reported offences were recorded in the Borough, which is a decrease of 171 (or -10.4%) on October 2023. The largest increase was in relation to Arson.
- Police generated crime, which includes crimes such as drug offences, public disorder and possession of weapons was 304 in October 2024 up by 13 (4.5%) versus October 2023. The largest increase was in relation to Trafficking of Drugs.
- Overall, there was a total of 1,797 crimes in the current period, equal to 154 (-7.9%) less crimes in October 2024 versus October 2023.
